

Grammar: **ability vs. obligation** - 'can' and 'have to'

'Can' expresses **ability**

Example: I can work at the restaurant or the hotel. (I have a choice)

'Have to' expresses **obligation**

Example: I have to work if I want to eat. (I don't have a choice)

Write the banking activity under 'can' or 'have to.'

- Pay a fee at an ATM (not my bank)
- Use ATM card at stores, gas stations or supermarkets
- Get money orders from my bank
- Pay extra to cash a check at a check cashing business
- Call the bank to get information
- Use the internet to find out about your account
- Pay interest when you get a loan
- Have enough money in my account to write a check
- Sign my name to checks for payment
- Pay bills with my checks
