

Yes-No Questions

There are two types of questions: **yes/no** and **information**.

Yes/No Questions - the answer is yes or no.

A. In a question with the verb “to be” (am is, are), the verb jumps to the front of the sentence.

Examples:

Is she in pain?
Yes, She is in pain. (Yes, she is.)
No, She is not in pain. (No, she isn't.)

Am/Is/Are	Subject	Adjective
Am	I	In pain?
Is	he	In pain?
	she	
	it	

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Are they in pain?  
(Yes) They are in pain. (Yes, they are.)  
(No) They are not in pain. (No, they aren't.)

**B. In a yes/no question with an action verb, you need to use do or does at the beginning**

| Do/Does | Subject | Verb | Complement |
|---------|---------|------|------------|
| Do      | I       | have | pain?      |
|         | we      |      |            |
|         | you     |      |            |
|         | they    |      |            |
| Does    | he      |      |            |
|         | she     |      |            |
|         | it      |      |            |

Examples:

**Do you have pain?**  
(Yes) I have pain.  
(Yes, I do.)

**Does he have pain?**  
(Yes) He has pain.  
(Yes, he does.)

**Do you come to class?** Yes, I come to class.

**Do I come to class?** Yes, you come to class.

**Does he come to class?** Yes, he comes to class.

**Do you come to class?** Yes, we come to class.



**Do you have pain?** Yes, I have pain.
