

Practice Parent-Teacher Conference Questions

Questions a parent (mother or father) can ask a teacher:

1. How is my child doing in school?
2. Does he/she participate in class?
3. Does he/she do his/her homework?
4. What are his/her best subjects?
5. What subjects does he/she need to improve?
6. Do you have any suggestions about how I can help him/her at home to do better at school?
7. Does he/she have any problems in the classroom?
8. Does he/she have any problems with his/her friends?
9. Does he/she have any problems with bullying or being bullied in school?
10. Does my son/daughter have any problems paying attention in class, or are there any behaviors you are worried about?

VOCABULARY:

Participate= the student talks about and does activities in class ☺

Homework= work to do at home for school

Subjects= class topics, like art, math, science, English, gym, social studies, etc.

Improve= to get better

Suggestions= advice for how to do something

Bullying= when a student is not nice to another student

Being bullied= when a student is scared of another student because that student is not nice to him/her

Behaviors= way a student acts in class

Paying attention= listening to the teacher when he/she is talking, studying, doing well in class subjects
