

You and the student will take turns helping each other complete the crossword by explaining the words that one has that the other doesn't (so, for example, tutor will describe the horizontal words and student will describe the vertical words. That way you will each fill in the crossword, and they will match.

Crossword Hints

Assembly – a meeting of all of the students in a school

Assignment – a classroom task

Auditorium – a big room for concerts and assemblies

Cafeteria – where students eat

Classroom – a room for a teacher and many students to study

Deadline – a date or time something must be completed

Extra Credit – optional work students do to improve a grade

Field Trip – a visit to a place outside of school for students to learn

Fire Drill – a time to practice emergency procedures

Grade – a level in school (like: 5th) OR a score (like: A)

Group Work – an assignment some students must do together

Gym – where students practice sports and exercise

Homework – assignments to do at home

L.M.C. – the school library

Locker – a cabinet where students can store their things

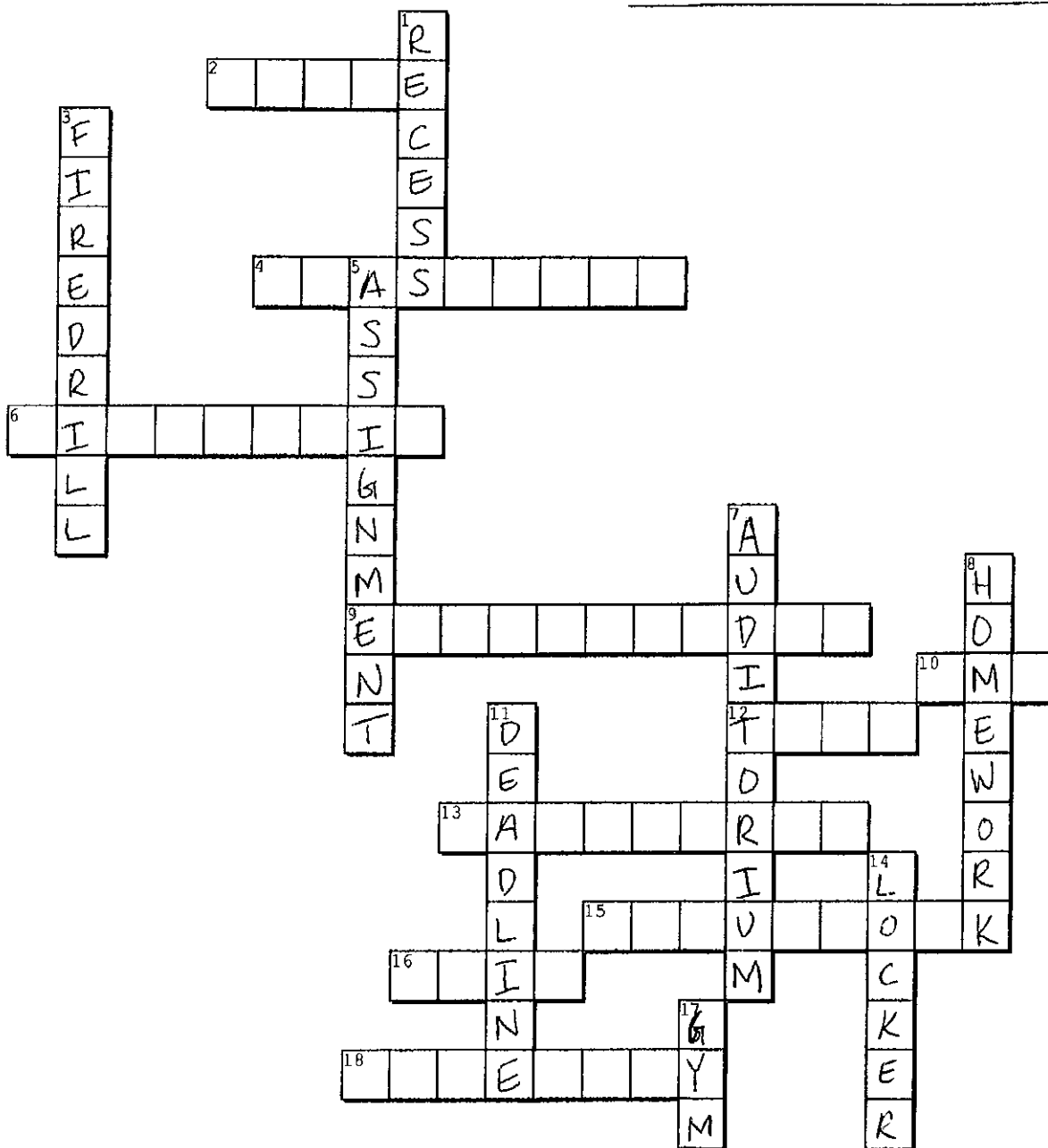
Quiz – a short test without a lot of preparation

Test – an exam students take to measure their knowledge

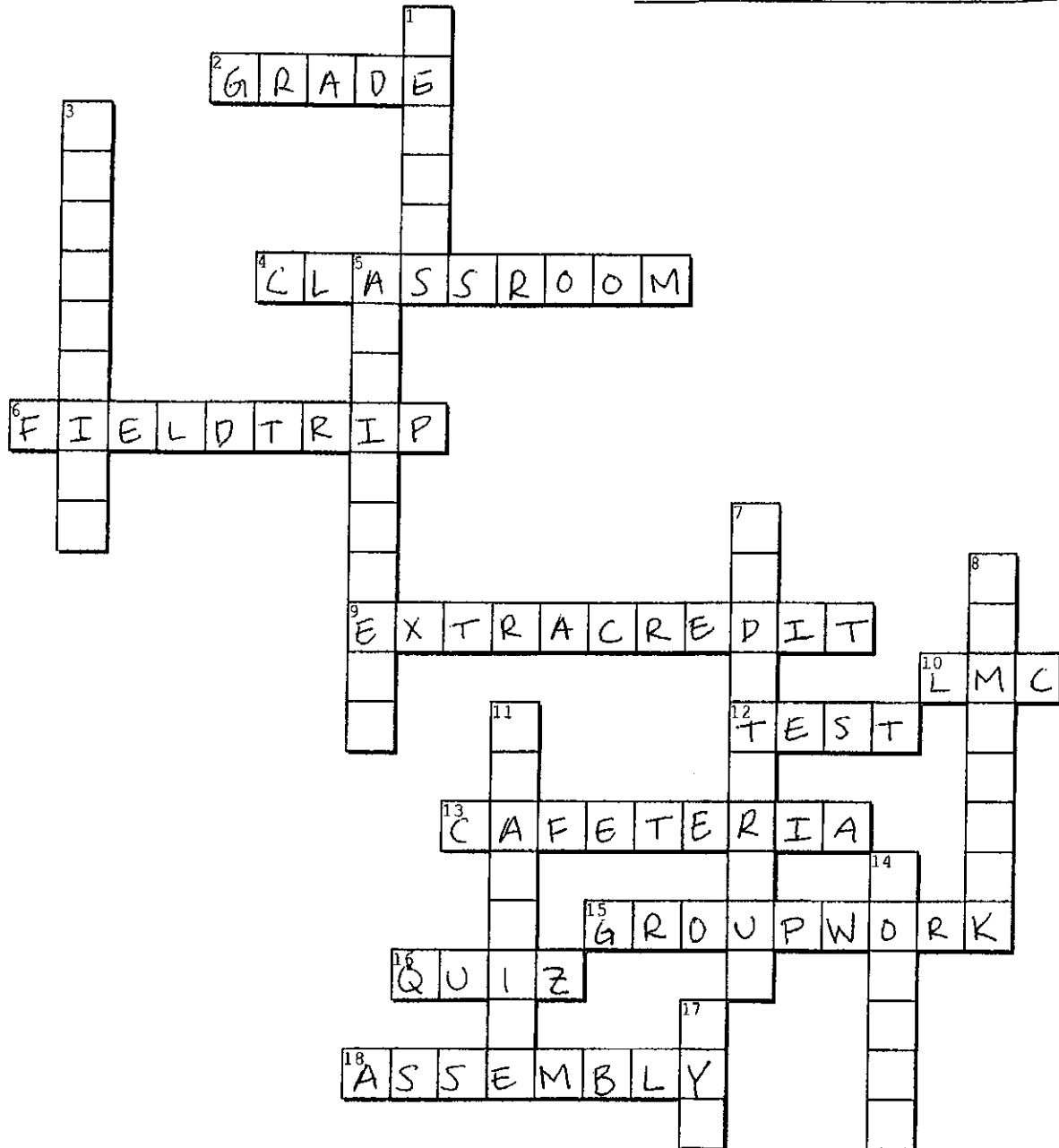
