

You and the student will take turns helping each other complete the crossword by explaining the words that one has that the other doesn't (so, for example, tutor will describe the horizontal words and student will describe the vertical words. That way you will each fill in the crossword, and they will match.

Crossword Hints

Author—a person who wrote a book

Back cover—back of a book

Book—something you borrow from a library that has writing and pictures

Computer—a machine for typing and using the internet

Dialogue—writing that tells you what a character *says*

Due date—the day you have to bring your books back to the library

Ebook—an electronic book

Fiction—the category of books and novels that are not true

Illustration—a picture or image in a book

Internet—you can check email or use Google on it

Librarian—a person who administers or assists in a library

Library card—an ID that allows you to check out books

Newspaper—something you read for the news

Non-fiction—the category of books about true events or real things

Page number—tells you which page you're on

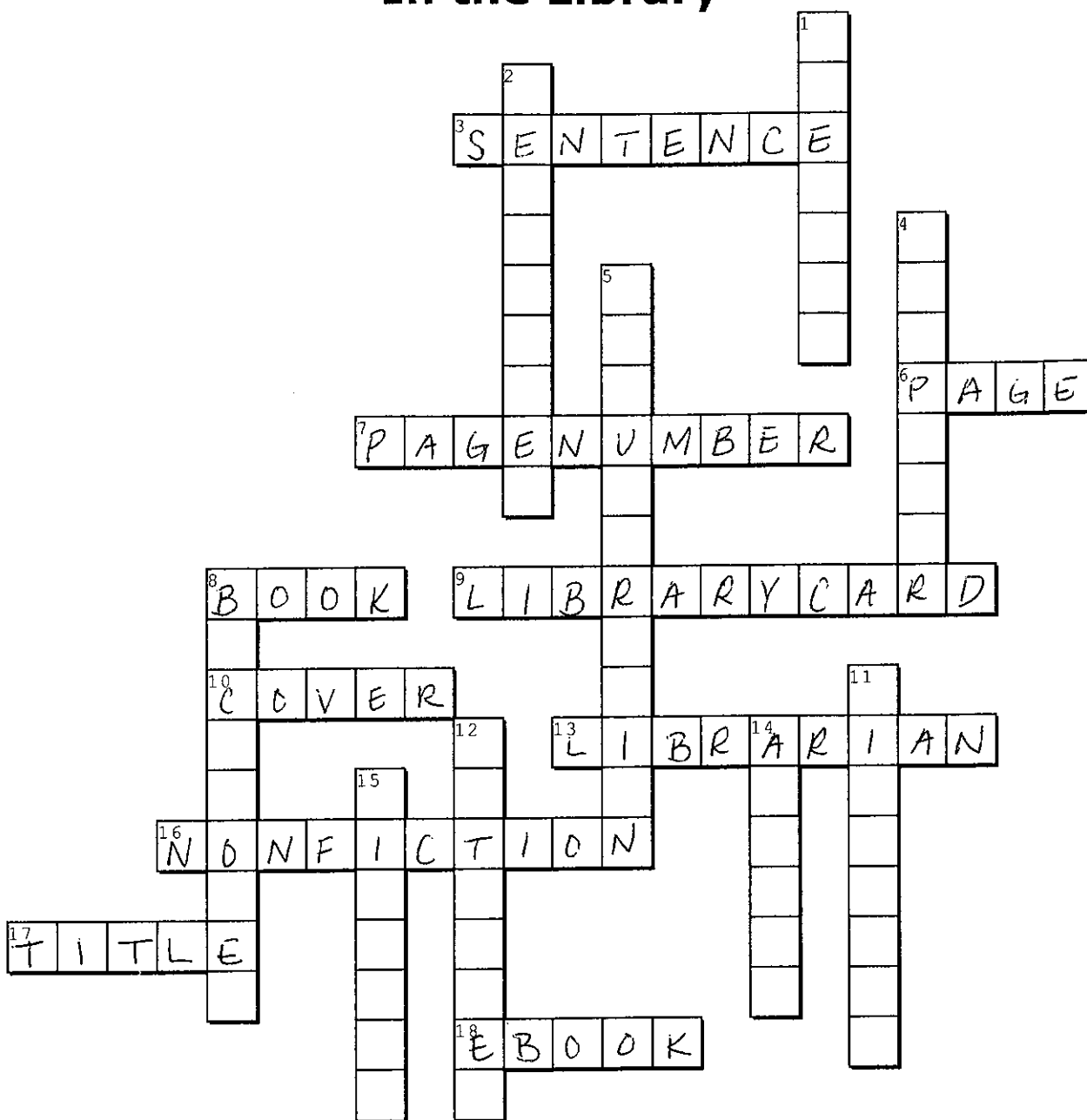
Page—a sheet of paper in a book

Sentence—A phrase in a book, starts with a capital letter and ends with a period.
