

Questions about Workers' Rights

1. What should you do to file a complaint about your supervisor?
2. If you do not have a union, can your boss fire you without a reason?
3. Is it discrimination if your supervisor says that you cannot speak your native language (Spanish, French, Tibetan, Chinese, Czech) at work?
4. Is it discrimination if your supervisor treats you badly because you are not white?
5. Is it discrimination if your supervisor treats you badly because you have a different religion?
6. Does your job have to offer paid vacation days or paid sick days?
7. If you work for a big company (more than 50 employees) and you have a baby, can your boss fire you if you take 2 months off of work?
8. If you have a sick child at home and you call in sick, can your boss fire you if you don't come to work?
9. Can your supervisor treat you differently because you filed a complaint against him?
10. If you go to the Worker's Rights Center for help, what should you try to bring with you?
11. Is it helpful to have a witness if you file a complaint?
12. If you fall and hurt your leg while you are taking out the garbage at work, does your company have to pay for the medical bills?
13. After you clock out, if you slip on the wet floor at your job, does your company have to pay for the medical bills?
